## LAW № 9165 ON ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FROM THE STATE FUND FOR REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT WAS APPROVED

The Verkhovna Rada adopted draft law No. 9165, which provides for a mechanism of public participation - voting by Ukrainians through Diia for projects financed from the State Regional Development Fund. This year's budget of UAH 2 billion was allocated to increase defence capability.

Such a decision allows the allocation of funds from the State Fund for Regional Development (SFRD) on projects that suffered the most from the war. Previously, the SFRD's allocation rules took into account population and gross regional product, but these indicators are not relevant during the war.

### **HROMADAS OF 10 OBLASTS OF UKRAINE WILL RECEIVE UAH 5.3 BILLION FOR RECONSTRUCTION**

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine has decided to distribute almost UAH 5.3 billion in subventions to communities in 10 regions of the country:

- Vinnytsia region - UAH 373.6 million;
- Dnipropetrovs'ka oblast - UAH 519.1 million;
- Zhytomyr region - UAH 445.4 million;
- Kyiv region - UAH 2.4 billion;
- Kirovohrad region - UAH 244.2 million;
- Odesa region - UAH 455.2 million;
- Poltava region - UAH 643.7 million;
- Sumy region - UAH 82.2 million;
- Cherkasy region - UAH 98.9 million;
- Chernihivs'ka - UAH 42.9 million.

The funds will be used to restore 109 facilities, including educational and healthcare institutions, administrative service centres, critical infrastructure, etc.

### **THE GAS TRANSMISSION SYSTEM OPERATOR OF UKRAINE (GTSOU) RECEIVED 68 TONNES OF EQUIPMENT FROM PARTNERS TO RESTORE AND MAINTAIN STABLE OPERATIONS**

The companies provided mobile and stationary generators from Poland and the UK, LED floodlight sets for lighting towers from Turkey and Canada, uninterruptible power supplies and external battery cabinets from Germany.

Since the beginning of the year, we have raised over UAH 500 million. This includes equipment, materials, machinery, financing of works, etc. In addition, as part of the assistance from the Energy Support Fund of Ukraine, GTSOU is expected to receive five automatic gas distribution stations (AGDS) with a capacity of 5,000 m<sup>3</sup>/hour.

### **RESULTS OF THE EVENT “EU PLAN FOR €50 BILLION. WHAT SHOULD UKRAINE DO?”**

As per results of the conference «EU Plan for €50 billion. What should Ukraine do?», there were 3 priority areas identified: macro stability, public infrastructure investment and private investment. The goal is to engage business into development of the Ukrainian Plan that is required to implement the European Commission’s €50 billion Ukraine Facility financial assistance programme for 2024-2027.

As of the end of July the Ministry of Economy created 5 out of 10 sectoral working groups: energy, agriculture, transport and logistics, IT and communications, and industry (machine building, critical materials).

According to Deputy Minister of Economy Oleksiy Sobolev, the document is expected to be finalised by the end of October this year.

### **KHERSON POWER ENGINEERS RECEIVE 37 TRANSFORMERS TO RESTORE POWER SUPPLY AFTER KAKHOVKA HPP EXPLOSION**

JSC Khersonoblenergo received 37 transformers and 5 km of steel-aluminium wire with a total weight of 36 tonnes provided by partners from Sweden, Finland and the Netherlands. The equipment will help speed up the restoration of electricity supply in the affected area. Currently, more than 12,000 customers in Kherson are without electricity due to flooding.

### **SWEDEN WILL PROVIDE APPROXIMATELY 522 MILLION EUROS ON PROJECTS FOR UKRAINE'S RESTORATION**

The Swedish Government presented a Strategy of cooperation in the Ukraine's reconstruction and reform areas for 2023-2027 that will allocate SEK 6 billion (522,6 million euros) on projects for recovery of Ukraine: infrastructure reconstruction, green development, entrepreneurship, trade, demining, and media support in Ukraine.
