Mosaic of Russian economic news for January 2025

- Russia continues to benefit from the sale of its energy resources, despite certain difficulties, but foresees a reduction in profits from their exports in the future.
- The main problems in the economy are felt by business and the population, which are not related to exports or war. The budget has a deficit budget for the third year in a row. The Russian economy is facing a threat of a large-scale jump in corporate bankruptcies.
- Sanctions and the large resource burden of the war create many complex structural problems that will be difficult to overcome in the future: technological backwardness, personnel hunger, dependence on China, which takes the opportunity to benefit from Russia's situation.

• In order to bluff and hide high inflation and other negative trends, the Russians have decided to hide statistical data, which potentially, together with ineffective state management, will create additional problems for economic institutions, enterprises that will build their strategies blindly.

Mosaic of socio-political news from Russia for January 2025

- The population that does not earn money from the war is becoming poorer, oppressed and depressed not only due to growing poverty, but also due to additional repressions, restrictions on access to sources of information.
- In trying to restore the so-called "sphere of interest", Russia has achieved the opposite: NATO has become closer, raw material markets have been lost, and influence over former allies has decreased. Experts observe that the Kremlin does not have a clear understanding of the ways to end the war and realistic conditions for negotiations.
